The conference seeks to create a multidisciplinary dialogue by bringing together academicians, policymakers, researchers, social activists, and spiritual leaders. - Online communities and virtual spaces for women's spiritual engagement.
- Digital tools and apps supporting mindfulness and meditation for women.
- The role of social media in amplifying women's spiritual leadership.

#### **Organizational Structure**

#### **Submission Guidelines:**

Abstracts are called for the theme- "Women's Journeys of Resilience and Empowerment Stories and Strategies: Spiritual Strength". Abstract must clearly define the objectives, methodology, findings and significance of the study and should not be more than 500 words typed in Times New Roman, font 12 size with double spacing, paper size-A4, preferably with margins left1, right 0-8, top 1, bottom 0-8. Only word files will be accepted. It must contain Key-words. A sample of the same will be uploaded along with the Call for Papers notice.

#### Full Paper Contains (within 5000-6000 words):

Full Paper consists of (i) Title of the Paper, (ii) Name & Designation of the Author(s), and Name of the Institution, (iii) Abstract and Keywords. (1) Introduction; (2) Literature Review; (3) Research Gap, (4) Research/ Study/ Project Objectives and Hypothesis (if any); (5) Methodology; (6) Body; (7)Results/ Findings; (10) Conclusion; (11) References.

**Note-** Citations are must within the Body of the Article. Permissible limit of Plagiarism of your Article is 10%.
