EVENTS ORGANIZED BY THE DEPARTMENT

On June 7 and 8, 2021, the Department had hosted a seminar titled "NEP 2020: Towards Inclusivity and Multidisciplinary in Higher Education."Prominent education experts, including Prof. B. Ramesh Babu, Prof. and Dean, Research, RIE, Bhopal; Prof. S.M. Sungoh, Prof. of Education, NEHU; and Prof. Hrushikesh Senapaty, former Director, NCERT; Dr. Amarendra Pani, Joint Director, Research Association of Indian Universities, held discussions ona range of NEP 2020 topics pertaining to co-operation and inclusivity in Education.



On February 7, 2022, the Department of Education conducted an online webinar titled NEP-2020: The Hope for Indian sing the Curriculum in Higher Education. Attendee resource person for this program was Dr. Sushanta Kumar Panda, Assistant Professor of Education at the University of Jammu.

The Department of Education hosted a seminar discussion on January 5, 2022. A lecture on "Extension Services in Higher Education" was given by Prof. Surekha Sundari Swain, Principal of Shailabala Women's Autonomous College, Cuttack. She highlighted the importance of extensive services for the quality development of higher education.



On January 7, 2021, a program of orientation was held for newly admitted UG and PG students.
