INVITED LECTURES

In the course of his lecture he discussed about emerging concerns in Indian education, its characteristics, and importance in 21st Century. The lecture was followed by a question-answer session on various aspects of learning and assessment

A Seminar on 'Role of Teacher in the contextt of Four-Pillars of Education' was organized by the Department on 17th Dec 2018. Dr. Sesadeba Pany, Assistant Professor of Education, Central University of Panjab was the Resource Personson. He discussed about the concept of four pillars of education in a very lucid manner and emahsized the role of teachers in a fast changing society.
