Our student Deblina Ghosh received Gold Medal from the Honourable President of India for securing highest mark in B.Ed. examination, 2022.

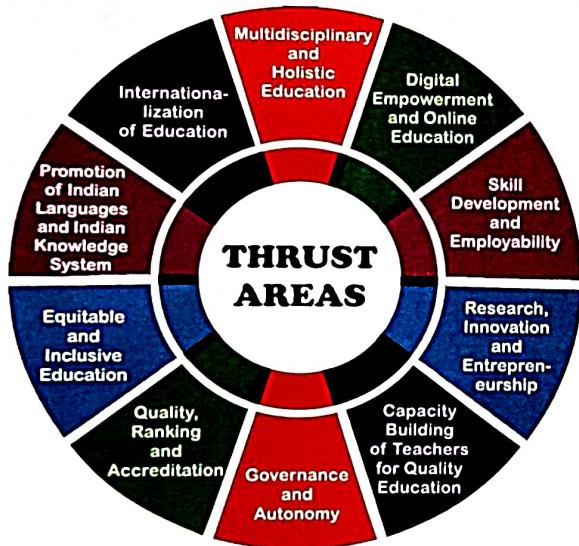
