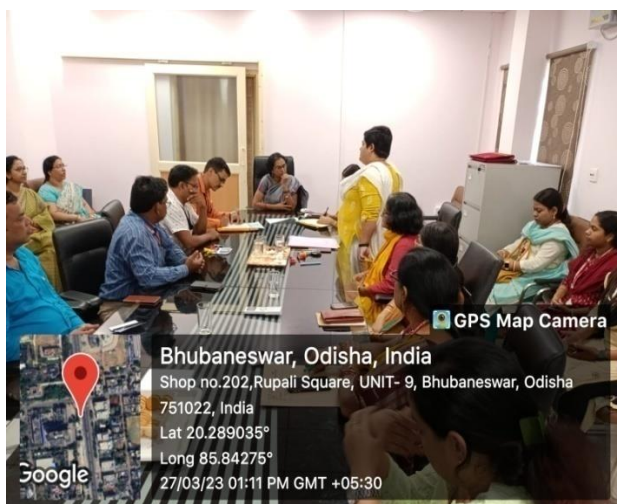

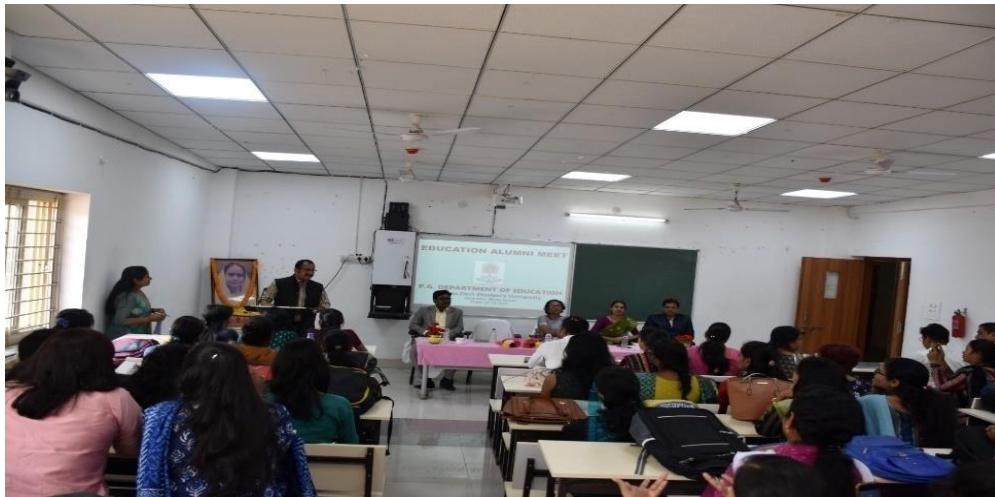


Welcome Address by Dr. Sankar Prasad Mohanty, HoD, Education
