The department introduced five value added course and also lunched the Certificate course in disability studies for the academic session 2022-23. Nearly 145 students joined as the first batch. Home Science in Post graduation programme. The department organizes seminars regularly. Being an interdisciplinary field, the scope of research extends to many areas with the passage of time. There are around 15 numbers of research scholars enrolled for this academic session 2022-23.
