- Spreading of statistical literacy, strengthening future research and create enthusiasm, interest and passion in the study of statistics.

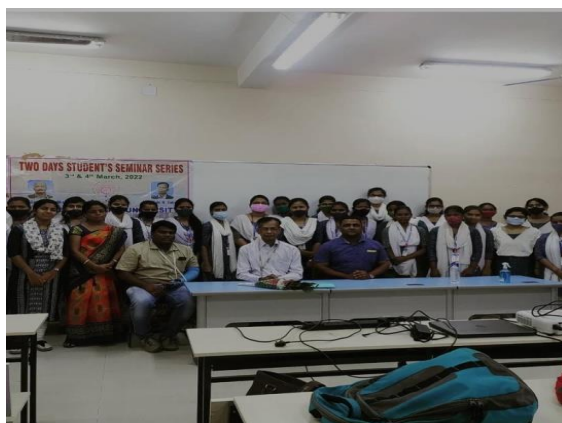
MISSION OF THE DEPARTMENT
