1. About the Department:

Department of Teacher Education was established in 2018 under the School of Pedagogical Sciences, Rama Devi Women's University. The Department offers two-year B.Ed. programme (Self-finance) with one unit of 50 seats(25 for Science and 25 for Arts). The course is recognised by NCTE and it offers the syllabus prescribed by SCERT, Govt. of Odisha which is also based on NCTE Curriculum Framework for Two-Year B.Ed. Programme. The curriculum of B.Ed.(Bachelor of Education) is unique of its kind that caters to the needs of the learners and helps them to fulfil the bread and butter aim of education. Since the day of its inception, the department has shown commendable progress in various fields such as guidance and counselling, community service and development of teaching learning resources. The uniqueness of the department lies in its School Internship programme which has been organised every year in eight Cooperating schools of the city. The department also provides Advanced Learning Exposures (ALE) such as OSSTET and CTET coaching, group dynamics, team building, mentoring etc. to its students. The alumni of the department are well placed in various Govt. and Non-Government organisations.
