




A seminar on 'Research Perspectives in Knowledge Generation and Validation' was organized by the department on 13.09.2023. Dr. Dibakar Sarangi, Principal, Dr, PMIASE, Sambalpur acted as the chief speaker of the event. Dr. Sarangi has elaborated about how to produce valid knowledge in the context of research. He has also talked about the method of knowing employed knowledge, interpretation of evidences and generalizability of knowledge.

A seminar cum workshop on 'Writing Research Proposal' was organized by Department on 30.09.2023. Dr.Sesadeba Pany, Associate Professor of Education, Central University of Punjab, Bathinda, India acted as the resource person. This seminar has been conducted through online mode via Google Meet. Dr. Pany has explained each step for writing research proposal in a systematic manner with suitable examples. All the steps including identification of research problem, importance of review of related literature, rationale of the study, statement of the problem, objectives of the study, formulation of the hypothesis, design of the study etc. were discussed in a systematic manner.





Dr. Arti Srivastava, Senior fellow, at Ravenshaw University, Cuttack delivered a lecture on Reflective Thinking for Futuristic Society on 25.11.2023. Highlighting the importance of conscious mind for social transformation, Dr. Srivastava explained the strategies to improve reflective thinking among students. She also described the importance of Indian Knowledge System and its influence on reflective thinking.



The Department organized a seminar on "Language Across the Curriculum". Prof. Manoj Kumar Pradhan, Principal, Govt. B.Ed. College Kalinga, Kandhamal stated that language is crucial for students' academic success and beyond. By developing language skills in conjunction with subject specific knowledge, students enhance their understanding, critical thinking and communication abilities.



An Extramural lecture on Life Skill Education was organized for students. Dr. Manini Biswal, Assistant Professor of Education, RNIASE, Cuttack highlighted the essence of life skill education in our day-to-day life. Further, she also elaborated the life skills given by WHO which are Self-awareness empathy, critical thinking, creative thinking, decision making problem solving, effective communication, interpersonal relationship, coping with stress and coping with emotion.

#### **ALUMNI MEET 2024**


