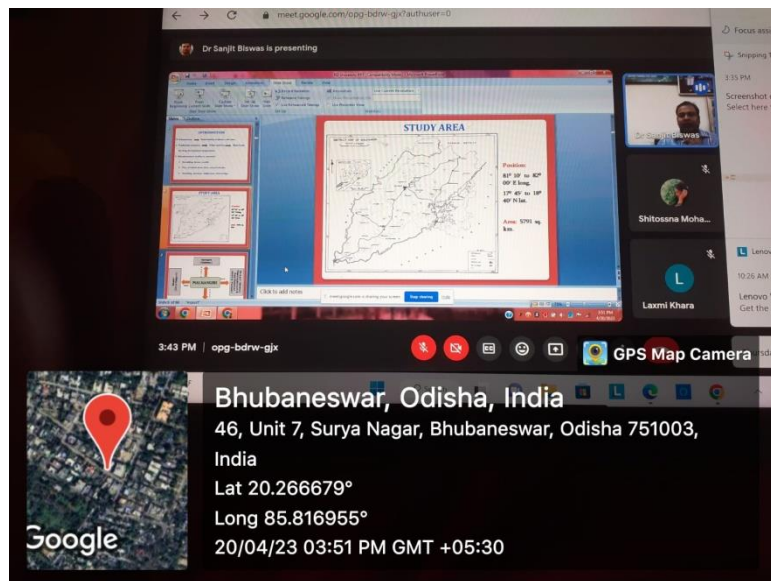

8. **Outcome of the event:** The webinar focussed on the ethnobotanical survey of 34 plant species used by tribal people of Malkangiri, district, Odisha, the wide-spread use of traditional medicine prevalence over modern medicine in the study area, briefing about Herbarium (information about where certain plant species grow, what type of habitats species like, and at what time of year plants bloom and make fruits).
9. **Recommendations:** Collecting plants and using herbarium techniques (collection procedure, field note, pressing, re-pressing, drying techniques, Mounting herbarium specimens, Labelling etc.) to be used in research, education and conservation
