11. Outcomes of the Event:

- Prof. Vijay Kumar Chechi delivered his lecture on "*Paradigms of Research in Education*". In course of his discussion, Prof. Chechi focused on the concept of research paradigms in education. He added, the researcher should cautiously carry out a research work. Besides he also discussed the mixed method approach. Different types of research such as Ethnography, Case Study, Grounded theory, Narrative Research, Action Research etc. were discussed by him. He suggested that the researcher should remain unbiased and maintain confidentiality while strictly adhering to research ethics.
- Prof. B.N. Panda, Dean of Research, Regional Institute of Education, NCERT, Bhubaneswar delivered a lecture on "*Higher Education in India: Quality, Challenges and Measures*". The concept of higher education along with its Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities and Threats (SWOT) were explained in detail by Prof. Panda. Emphasizing the importance of higher education, Prof. Panda said that higher

education is as important as primary and secondary education for nation building. Higher education is meant for knowledge creation. The indicators of quality in higher education as well as the present 2020 draft on higher education were also elaborated by him. As the role of leaders are important to maintain quality, it is essential to develop leadership quality among the stakeholders of education.

- iii. Prof. Anil Kumar, Former Professor and Head, National Institute of Technical Teachers' Training and Research, Bhopal, delivered a lecture on the topic "*Management of Assessment and Examination in Higher Education*" during Covid-19. During the course of his lecture, he discussed about the role of national bodies to introduce examination reforms in higher education. Various reforms such as Grading system, CBCS, Semester system of examination, Continuous and Comprehensive Assessment, maintaining Portfolio/e-Portfolios of students etc. were focused in the lecture.
- iv. Prof. Nityananda Pradhan, Principal, Regional Institute of Education, NCERT, Bhopal, addressed the valedictory session by highlighting on the topic "*Curricular Reforms and its Management in Higher Education*". The main points highlighted by Prof. Pradhan includes the concept of curriculum and reforms, factors contributing to reforms with special reference to the Global challenges of higher education, aims of Indian higher education and models of curriculum development. Various models of curriculum development such as Tyler Model, Hilda Taba Model, Miller and Seller's Model etc. were analysed along with the NCERT approach to school curriculum development in India. Focusing the aims of higher education, Prof. Pradhan said that education aims at the development of employability (Employment+ Generic skills), advance learning, learning skills and research, creation of knowledge, promotion creativity and innovation, transmitting a common culture among citizens and many more.

12. Recommendations :

- i. Quality of Higher Education can be enhanced through exploring actual learning needs through research.
- ii. Both qualitative and quantitative approaches of research are essential for this purpose. Scope to be provided to conduct such researches with intuitional funding or funding by external agencies.
- iii. Different types of research such as Ethnography, Case Study, Grounded theory, Narrative Research, Action Research etc. should be conducted by the faculty members, students of the higher education institutions to explore the ground realities.
- iv. Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities and Threats/Challenges need to be identified for quality higher education.
- v. As purpose of higher education is to create knowledge, maximum opportunities should be provided to the students and teachers for the purpose.

- vi. The existing curriculum should be revisited and reformed with reference to reference to the global challenges of higher education, aims of Indian higher education and models of curriculum development.
- vii. The curriculum should be designed in accordance to the models of curriculum development such as Tyler Model, Hilda Taba Model, Miller and Seller's Model, NCF-2005 etc.
- viii. Higher education should aim at development of employability (Employment+ Generic skills), advance learning, learning skills and research, creation of knowledge, promotion creativity and innovation, transmitting a common culture among citizens.
- ix. Freedom should be given to the learners to select which media to access, which resources to exploit, which tools to use and how, when and where to use them as 21st Century Pedagogy i.e. Pedagogy 2.0.
- x. Various reforms in examinations such as Grading system, CBCS, Continuous and Comprehensive Assessment, maintaining Portfolio/e-Portfolios of students etc. should be followed in higher education.
- xi. Importance should be given to virtual classroom and online examination during COVID-19 and also in post-covid period.

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DAY-1: DATE: 23 June 2020

Technical Session-I (Time: 11.30-1.00 pm)

P.G. Department of Education, under School of Pedagogical Sciences (Education) Rama Devi Women's University organized a Two-Day National Webinar on "Pedagogical Innovations in Higher Education during COVID-19" on 23 & 24 June, 2020. On the Day-1 during the inaugural session, the welcome address was delivered by Dr. Sankar Prasad Mohanty, Dean and Head of the Department of Education; and Dr. Mohanty presented the theme of the national webinar along with a brief introduction of the resource persons.

The national webinar was inaugurated by Professor Sasmita Mohanty, Chairperson, PG Council of the University. Prof. Mohanty presented her inaugural address

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in which she discussed on various aspects of new pedagogies in higher education to enhance quality in 21st century. She focused on the challenges of higher education during COVID-19 and suggested some measures to overcome such challenges by implementing innovative pedagogical approaches to meet the diverse learning needs of the learners.

During the first session, Prof. B.N.Panda could not join due to some technical problem in connectivity. Hence, the next a Resource Person, Prof. Vijay Kumar Chechi, Head, Department of Education, Lovely Professional University, Punjab was requested to deliver his lecture during the first session and Prof. B.N.Panda in the next session. Therefore, Prof. Vijay Kumar Chechi delivered his lecture on “*Paradigms of Research in Education*”. In course of his discussion, Prof. Chechi focused on the concept of research paradigms in education. Various aspects of both qualitative and quantitative research were discussed and it was said that the role of researcher is quite significant in selecting a research design. Further, he added, the researcher should cautiously carry out a research work. Besides he also discussed the mixed method approach. Different types of research such as Ethnography, Case Study, Grounded theory, Narrative Research, Action Research etc. were discussed by him. He suggested that the researcher should remain unbiased and maintain confidentiality while strictly adhering to research ethics.

Dr. Sasmita Kar, Assistant Professor acted as moderator of the session and briefed the lecture delivered by Prof. Chechi. Participants wanted to know some aspects in terms of various queries raised in the chat box. The questions were basically related to researchers’ bias in qualitative research, problem of data collection and credibility of research findings during this pandemic period; and feasibility of Action Research during COVID-19. Dr. Kar asked all such questions on behalf of the participants and all the queries were clarified by Prof. Chechi. The lecture was appreciated by most of the participants.

The session was ended by vote of thanks extended by Dr. Sankar Prasad Mohanty, HoD. Department of Education, Rama Devi Women’s University.

Technical Session -II (Time: 02.30 pm -04.00 pm)

During the second session, Professor B.N. Panda, Dean of Research, Regional Institute of Education, NCERT, Bhubaneswar delivered a lecture on “*Higher Education in India: Quality, Challenges and Measures*”. The concept of higher education along with its Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities and Threats (SWOT) were explained in detail by Prof. Panda. Emphasizing the importance of higher education, Prof. Panda said that higher education is as important as primary and secondary education for nation building. Higher education is meant for knowledge creation. The indicators of quality in higher education as well as the present 2020 draft on higher education were also elaborated by him. As the role of leaders are important to maintain quality, it is essential to develop leadership quality among the stakeholders of education. Besides this, he also gave a comprehensive

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data about the number of higher education institutions in India including universities, colleges, IITs and institutes of technical institution.

Dr. Ashok Kumar Digal, Assistant Professor, acted as moderator of the session and summarized the topic discussed by Prof. Panda. Participants were primarily interested to know about the accessibility of quality higher education for children with special needs and children belonging to marginalized group of society. They also raised questions regarding the assurance of quality in higher education during pandemic period and their queries were answered by Prof. Panda.

The session was ended by vote of thanks extended by Dr. Sankar Prasad Mohanty, HoD of Education, Rama Devi Women's University.

DAY-2: DATE: 24 June 2020**Technical Session -III (Time: 11.30-1.00 pm)**

During the session-I in the second day of the national webinar, Professor Anil Kumar, Former Professor and Head, National Institute of Technical Teachers' Training and Research, Bhopal, delivered a lecture on the topic "*Management of Assessment and Examination in Higher Education*" during Covid-19. During the course of his lecture, he discussed about the role of national bodies to introduce examination reforms in higher education. Various reforms such as Grading system, CBCS, Semester system of examination, Continuous and Comprehensive Assessment, maintaining Portfolio/e-Portfolios of students etc. were focused in the lecture. The importance of virtual classroom and online examination during COVID-19 were highlighted by Prof. Anil Kumar.

Being the moderator, Dr. Sasmita Kar summarized the talk by Professor Anil Kumar and the queries raised by the participants were asked by her. Prof. Anil Kumar clarified all the queries. Questions were also asked about the evaluation of B.Ed. students' projects and other practical activities who were unable to do their internship due to closure of schools for COVID-19. Queries were duly satisfied by the presenter. The session was ended with a formal vote of thanks by Dr. Sasmita Kar.

Technical Session -IV : Valedictory Session (Time: 02.30 pm -04.00 pm)

Professor Nityananda Pradhan, Principal, Regional Institute of Education, NCERT, Bhopal addressed the valedictory session by highlighting on the topic "*Curricular Reforms and its Management in Higher Education*". The main points highlighted by Prof. Pradhan includes the concept of curriculum and reforms, factors contributing to reforms with special reference to the Global challenges of higher education, aims of Indian higher education and models of curriculum development. Various models of curriculum development such as Tyler Model, Hilda Taba Model, Miller and Seller's Model etc. were analysed along with the NCERT approach to school curriculum development in India.

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Focusing the aims of higher education, Prof. Pradhan said that education aims at the development of employability (Employment+ Generic skills), advance learning, learning skills and research, creation of knowledge, promotion creativity and innovation, transmitting a common culture among citizens and many more. With special emphasis on 21st Century Pedagogy i.e. Pedagogy 2.0, he stated that this pedagogy allows freedom to learners to select-which media to access, which resources to exploit, which tools to use and how, when and where to use them.

The presentation was briefly summarized by Dr. Sasmita Kar, moderator of the session. Then participants were asked to ask questions and give their valuable suggestions. Most of the questions were related to the curricular reforms during post COVID-19. Participants raised questions about the feasibility of framing new curriculum during this pandemic and suggested the involvement of student representatives in the construction of curriculum. The queries were clarified by Prof. Pradhan.

Vote of thanks was extended by Dr. Ashok Kumar Digal, faculty member, Department of Education, Rama Devi women's University.

Briefing the whole webinar, Dr. Sankar Prasad Mohanty, HoD, Department of Education remarked, 'This webinar is a stepping stone towards giving a national identity to the department.' He rendered special thanks to all the resource persons for their valuable contribution in making the webinar a grand success. Two hundred seventy six (276) participants have attended the webinar. 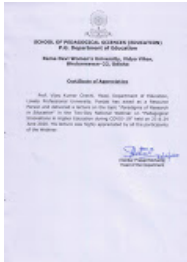

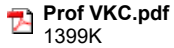
