



Alumni Feedback Analysis 2021-22

During the academic year 2021, feedback was gathered to elicit alumni' perspectives on the activities orchestrated by the department/university. The objective was to evaluate the overall satisfaction and effectiveness of these initiatives.




When queried about the department's organized activities, 41.3% of alumni rated the performance as excellent, while 36.3% considered it very good, and 18.8% found it to be just good. Additionally, 2.5% stated the activities not to be very good, but average.




Approximately 33.8% of alumni expressed satisfaction with the facilities provided by the department/university, citing numerous learning and development opportunities as excellent. Another 35% considered these facilities as very good, emphasizing their significance in


enhancing curriculum diversity. Additionally, approximately 25% rated them as good, while 6.3% provided a fair/average response.



To respond to the question about the learning values acquired in terms of concepts, knowledge, skills, analytical abilities, broadening perspectives, and applicability to real-life situations, approximately 33.8% of the alumni described the learning values acquired by the students from the institution's performance as excellent, 40% as very good, and a 23.8% as good. Whereas 2.5% thought it was average.



Responding to the question, 36.3% of alumni found the relevance and updating of course curriculums to be excellent, 42.5% deemed it very good, 15% considered it good, 5% rated it as average, and 1.3% expressed it as poor.



In response to the question concerning the status of communication with the department, approximately 32.5% of alumni considered it excellent, while 40% found it very good. Almost 21.3% of alumni responded as good, with the remaining 6.3% rating it as average.
