Brief Report	A two-day International Conference 2025 was organized by the Maa Rama Devi Chair on 28th February and 1st March 2025. The inaugural ceremony was held on 28th February 2025. The Chief Guest of the ceremony was Smt. Aparajita Sarangi, Hon'ble MP, Bhubaneswar. The Chief Speaker of the session was Ms. Tamasin Ramsay, an anthropologist from Australia. The Guest of Honour was Smt. Kasturi Jal, a social activist from the Kalahandi district of Odisha. Other dignitaries present at the inaugural session included the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor (I/C), Prof. Chandi Charan Rath; Maa Rama Devi Chair Professor, Prof. Sucheta Priyabadini; and the Organizing Secretary of IC 2025, Dr. Sasmita Kar. The abstracts contributed by eminent academicians, scholars, and social activists for the conference were compiled into a souvenir (Abstract book) named <i>Sankalp</i> , which was launched on the occasion along with the MRDC logo. The inaugural session was followed by a
	plenary session chaired by Prof. Sasmita Mohanty, Director, CDC. Prof. Jaesup Park, Professor and Dean of International Affairs at Midwest University, USA joined the session online and spoke on the theme. The session also had prominent offline guests, including Dr. Tamasin Ramsay, an anthropologist from Australia; Annie Whitman from New York; and Dr. Ghadeer Elmayah from Egypt. Ms. Swatee Saberi Upadhyay of Dept. Of Biotechnology was rapporteur for the session. This was followed by Technical Session 1, which was chaired by Mrs. Nadia Moghbelpour from the Baha'i Office of Public Affairs and Smt. Renuprava Nayak, Registrar, OUTR. A total of six papers were presented during the session. Both technical sessions, along with the inaugural ceremony, were hosted by Dr. Navneet Kaur.
