INTRODUCTION

Department of Gender Studies and Sarala Devi Centre for Gender Research of Rama Devi Women's University in collaboration with Policy Centre and Gender Lab, Miranda House, University of Delhi is organizing the 15 days Faculty Development Programme (FDP) entitled "**The Gendered Contours of the Pandemic: Reinventing Public Policy and Leadership**" to be held from 24th of August to 7th of September 2020 (at 4.30PM to 6.30PM).

MAJOR THEME

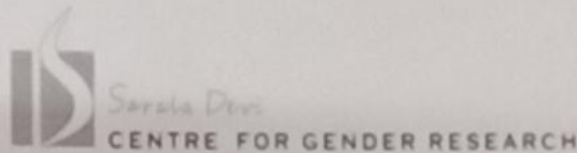

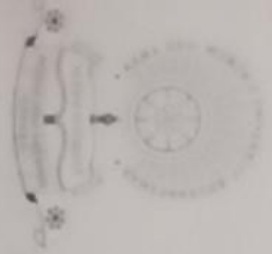

BRIEF REPORT ON THE WEBINAR

The International Webinar entitled "Need for Gender Research on Covid-19 Global Pandemic: Challenges and Prospects" was organized by the Department of Gender Studies and Sarala Devi Centre for Gender Research of Rama Devi Women's University on 4th July 2020. Dr. Jyotimayee Acharya Prof. & HOD of Dept. of Gender Studies and Coordinator of Sarala Devi Centre of Gender Research extended heartiest and warm welcome to the Vice Chancellor Prof. (Dr.) Padmaja Mishra, Chairperson PG Council, Prof. (Dr.) Sasmita Mohanty of Rama Devi Women's University and the distinguished speakers of the IW including the 786 participants and the faculty member of the department. Dr. Acharya shared that Sarala Devi Centre a Gender Research is a platform with specific objectives to conduct and invest in multidisciplinary gender research, inspire, translate and amplify gender scholarship and connect gender specialists and contribute towards gender parity and gender justice. Dr. Acharya requested the President of the IW Vice Chancellor Prof. (Dr.) Padmaja Mishra to formally inaugurate the IW and presents the opening remarks.

In the opening remarks Vice Chancellor Prof. (Dr.) Padmaja Mishra focused on the need for gender research on the Health impact of COVID-19 Pandemic, gender differential impact of COVID-19 Pandemic within the household (private space) and outside (public spaces), on the socio-economic and political dimensions and especially to address its effect upon higher education where the unequal access and mobility to online mode of education and technology might detriment the quality and rigor.

Dr. Annapurna Devi Pandey, Anthropology Department, University of California, Santa Cruz the USA has shared her research experience on "Gendered Impact of both International and interstate Migration during COVID-19 Global Pandemic". We are overwhelmed by the narrative of Indian diaspora status especially victimization of the female partners and wives in the USA which are visible through the Global patriarchy and

Governmentality (Foucault 1991) during COVID-19 Global Pandemic situation.

Dr. Bijayalaxmi Nanda, Acting Principal Miranda House University of Delhi, India presented the gender related challenges and Prospects while the pandemic continues. That gender issues are multidimensional, gender diversity and intersectional gender inequality research on COVID-19 Global Pandemic are important. However, research approaches should be more participatory and empathetic and research orient support mechanisms are critical. She has also pointed out how gender research policy lab of Miranda House is also advocating the need for a strategic essentialization (Spivak 1988, 1996) of the situation of gender discrimination. Madam Principal is also an active partner of the Sarala Devi Centre for Gender Research.

Dr. Smia Mishra Panda, Professor & Director Research, Centurion University of Technology and Management, Odisha presented a comprehensive research framework and deep insight into two important areas of gender research during COVID times: One is to rework on the gender research on the domestic violence against women and issues of migrant labour returnees to the Villages. The presentation has also emphasized on the consideration of feminist research methodological framework and policy implication.

Professor Dr. Bhagirath Behera, specialized in Environmental Economics, Department of Humanities and Social Studies, Indian Institute of Technology Kharagpur, India highlighted in his presentation how a sudden pandemic situation challenges the normative behavior and psychology of the people in the Western and Eastern Cultural context and its implication to spread the pandemic. Other highlights of his presentation are the zero sum thinking, short and long term collective interest, gender and leadership, individual and collective actions and the strategy for more effective online survey techniques and close to the reality of gender research on COVID Pandemic by maintaining physical distancing. The policy must protect the most vulnerable group especially, old age, poor women, migrant laborers, immigrants and informal sectors.

There were 786 numbers of participants in this International Webinar. Dr. J. Acharya extended their thanks to each of them, especially those who attended till the end, patiently listened to each of the speakers and found self-engaging in this subject area. Participants have joined through both google meet and live stream. Most of them were students, MPhil and PhD scholars including esteemed faculty members and members of the Civil Society from a diverse field of Humanities, Social Studies, Sciences, Pedagogies and Gender Studies. Participants have also shared a number of complimentary messages about their learning from the four brilliant presentations. Some of them actively engaged in the question answer sessions and due to time constraint we were not able to take more questions or comments from some participants.




