### MOU with NAANDI FOUNDATION

A memorandum of association (MOA) was signed with Naandi Foundation for the training of atleast 500 undergraduate and post graduate students of the University in employability skill sets related to soft skill, communication and inter-personal skills under the Mahindra Pride Class room programme.

#### MODE OF OPERATION

- The program was carried out with the students of Rama Devi Women's University, Bhubaneswar over a period of 12 months from 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022 to 31<sup>st</sup> August 2023.
- 2. The beneficiaries under this program were the students studying in the final year (UG/PG) courses in the Rama Devi Women's University, Bhubaneswar, Odisha.
- 3. The skilling program was for a **duration of 40 hours to 60 hours as** mutually agreed by the parties.
- 4. The program included Soft-Skills, Communication Skills, Life Skill and Interview preparations for the beneficiaries under employability skill development program.
- 5. The various courses that were undertaken under this programme include:
  - a. MPC employability skill training (40-60 hours)
