 - e. In UG 3rd semester, students shall read Communicative English in SEC-I as a compulsory subject.
 - f. UG 4th Semester students of Colleges getting funding assistance from the World Bank shall study "Quantitative Aptitude and Logical Reasoning" in SEC II as a compulsory subject. Students of Colleges not getting funding assistance from the World Bank shall study Entrepreneurship Development and Business Ethics as a paper in SEC II as a pool subject.
