3. Suggested practicals were added to each elective paper
4. It was resolved that students from all streams will be able to take NCC elective.
5. The students taking NCC elective have the choice of taking the elective for 2 or 4 semesters.
6. The syllabus was revised to correspond with the ACC '18' certificate syllabus and following guidelines in rule 11 - course design NCC
7. Only NCC - Army wing specialized subject was incorporated in the syllabus. as Rama Devi Women's University has NCC Army wing. the syllabus could be modified with the Navy wing special subjects if required.
8. Those institutes where NCC elective has not been implemented may offer the course for 2 semesters. Institutes where elective was implemented may offer upto 4 semesters
9. The other decisions taken in board BOS meeting held on 10.05.22 regarding paper letters/examiners, conduct of moderation board remain unchanged.
