Unit-III:- J. P. Sartre: (Humanism) is removed and Concept of man is added to the syllabus.


Unit-IV: (William James: Meaning and varieties of religious experience) are removed and Radical empiricism is added to the existing syllabus.

- f) The board approved the non-credit value added course.




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
