- A meeting was organised by OSHEC on 22.05.23 in this University with the Principals of all affiliated colleges to collect the feedback regarding implementation of NEP 2020 in UG curriculum and taking initiative for registering Students in ABC.
- ➤ The University has assigned by OSHEC with the work for preparation of curriculum of four subjects like Hindi, Home Science, Gender Studies and NCC compatible with NEP 2020.

Pani outlined the objective of the workshop i.e., to enable the COE of Universities and Autonomous Colleges to register with ABC, Digi locker, National Academic Depositary etc. and facilitate students joining the ABC and Digi locker.
