- The University has focused on outcome based education by adopting the CBCS pattern both in UG and PG Programmes.
- Field based learning / minor project / field internship is introduced as a part of curriculum in the UG & PG Programmes.
- Multidisciplinary course "Women and Society" is included in the curriculum across all disciplines of PG Programme with an objective to introduce students about the environment, technological and legal issues of women in Indian Society.
- Various Value added courses have been introduced with an aim to develop the ethical value.
- One certificates course in Disability study is introduced.
- Students are encouraged to register themselves in SWAYAM-MOOC courses. This is also included in the curriculum and regulations are developed integrating the grades or marks to their certificates.
- A meeting was organised by OSHEC on 22.05.23 in this University with the Principals of all affiliated colleges to collect the feedback regarding implementation of NEP 2020 in UG curriculum and taking initiative for registering Students in ABC.
- The University has assigned by OSHEC with the work for preparation of curriculum of four subjects like Hindi, Home Science, Gender Studies and NCC compatible with NEP 2020.
- University is also adopting the provision of Credit Transfer.



Registration of the participants was held from 10 AM to 10.30 AM. Prof. Aparajita Choudhary, Vice Chancellor, R.D. Women's University welcomed all to workshop and set the tone for discussion. She thanked Mr. Gaurav Khare, National Co-ordinator, Mr. Ravi Pandey, Zonal Co-ordinator and Ms. Lopamudra Nayak, State Coordinator for ABC and Digital India Corporation, National e-Governance Division, Ministry of Electronics & IT Dept. of Government of India for their participation. Prof. S.P. Pani outlined the objective of the workshop i.e., to enable the COE of Universities and Autonomous Colleges to register with ABC, Digi locker, National Academic Depository etc. and facilitate students joining the ABC and Digi locker. He explained how NEP-2020 is intrinsically linked with these Apps and Tools. Smt. Prativa Sahu OAS(SS), Member Secretary also welcomed the Resource Persons and thanked Prof. Aparajita Choudhary, Vice Chancellor, R.D. Women's University for hosting the event and extending all logistic support. She outlined the Govt. of Odisha's views on NEP-2020 in general and on ABC, Digi locker and NAD etc. She spoke about the keen interest of HED, Govt. of Odisha to implement these. Mr. Gaurav Khare, National Co-ordinator made introductory remarks and outlined the strategy of their organization.

Prof. Asoka Kumar Das, Vice Chairperson, OSHEC inaugurated the workshop. He impressed the participant on the need of both HEIs and students joining the ABC. He set the target at 15<sup>th</sup> June, 2023 for the Universities and Autonomous College to join ABC, NAD and Digi Locker etc. In the First Technical Session Mr. Gaurav Khare, National Co-ordinator, Mr. Ravi Pandey, Zonal Co-ordinator and Ms. Lopamudra, State Coordinator for ABC conducted the training program. A Q&A session was also conducted by them. Prof. P.K. Behera offered the vote of thanks to all.

In the post lunch period two sessions were held. The officials of Digital India assisted the COEs of Autonomous Colleges to register, made live demonstration and clarified doubts. COEs of Eight State Public Universities (Utkal University, Sambalpur University, Berhampur University, Rama Devi Women's University, Fakir Mohan University, Maharaja Sriram Chandra Bhanja Deo University, Ravenshaw University and Gangadhar Meher University), Prof. S.K. Das, Prof. P.K. Behera, Prof. T.K. Tripathy and Prof. S.P. Pani met to review the progress on the development of detailed curriculum etc. At the outset Prof. S.K. Das briefed members on the feedback received from various HEIs and subsequent revisions etc. Further, suggestions emerged on Odia Medium of examination, common fee structure, inclusion of ABC and Digi Locker information in the admission form etc. Prof. S.K. Das was requested to finalize the draft regulation. All the universities were advised to complete the process of preparing detailed curriculum for First Year by *15<sup>th</sup> June 2023* and Three year by *15<sup>th</sup> July, 2023* and Fourth year by *15<sup>th</sup> August, 2023*. However, they were advised to freeze the titles of all the courses by 15<sup>th</sup> June, 2023. Prof. Mamta Mohanty COE, Rama Devi Women's University offered a vote of thanks to all present. The meetings were conducted by Prof. S.P. Pani , Executive Member, OSHEC.

**Action Plan :-**

1. All the Autonomous Colleges and Universities will join NAD, ABC and Digi Locker latest by 15<sup>th</sup> June, 2023
2. The Universities and Autonomous College shall up load their data for first two years (i.e., 2021 admission batch 4 Semesters and 2022 batch Two Semester) latest by 15<sup>th</sup> July 2023. Further, they shall also upload the final year data as soon as the results are published
3. Where ever Aadhar Number of the students are not available the same shall be collected by the HEIs.
4. Data relating to all examination not limited to Three Year Degree Courses shall be uploaded.
5. The University/Autonomous College/Affiliated Colleges/ All HEIs to conduct awareness campaign and registration campaign for their students. HEIs shall identify few computer savy students who under the supervision of few teachers shall hold camps and assist students to get themselves register for Digi locker and ABC.
6. Universities will conduct awareness program for their affiliated colleges.
7. OSOU should also join ABC,NAD etc. Students of Open and Distance Learning students (i.e., DDCE) of universities are also to join ABC /Digi Locker.
8. M.S. Law University and Sri Jagannath Sanskrit University shall also join NAD/ABC/Digi Locker
9. Data of 2021 Admission Batch and onwards should be uploaded.
