Proceedings of the meeting of the College Development Council, RDWU on 13-09-2022

A virtual meeting of the principals was held on September 13, 2022 at 3 PM with the Director, CDC, Prof. Sasmita Mohanty on the chair. The CoE, Director Sports Council and DSW joined the meeting as special invitees.

At the outset, Prof. Sasmita Mohanty welcomed the august members and appraised the purpose of the meeting. The following agenda were discussed at the meeting:

- 1) Matters and issues regarding affiliations, NOCs, and fees submitted to the University
- 2) Examination related matters
- 3) Intercollege sports and cultural meet
- 4) Vishwavidyalaya Cup
- 5) Other matters, if any

1) Matters and issues regarding affiliations, NOCs, and fees submitted to the University

- i. Prof. Sasmita Mohanty, Director, CDC called out the principals of the colleges who have not paid the CDC fees and affiliation fees for the session 2021-22 and 2022-23. She urged the principals for the timely payment of the fees. Many of the principals had the opinion that they would deposit the CDC fees for 2022-23 as soon as the admission of the current batch of the students will be completed. Some of the principal were of opinion that the CDC fee should be according to the strength of the students admitted in a particular session and not on the basis of the sanctioned strength.
- ii. There is record of 7 colleges whose affiliations are not complete for 2013-14, 2014-15 with the Utkal University though they are already having affiliations from 2016-17 onwards from RDWU. Similarly, there are 15 colleges who have not applied/ received NOC from Utkal University. Prof. Mohanty, Director, CDC advised the principals of those colleges to do the needful and follow up at their level so that they could deposit the documents at the earliest.

2)Examination related matters

The CoE, RDWU, Dr Mamata Mohanty pointed out the following:

- i. Filling up of subjects particularly Generic Elective (GE) in the ROM should be done properly.
- ii. Completion of Form Fill up in due time as notified by the COE office from time to time
- iii. Selection of GE papers and teaching of GE from correct syllabus: If the student chooses to take two subjects as GE, she needs to the paper I and II from each paper in the consecutive years while in case of the student taking one subject as GE, she will have to take papers I, II, III and IV of the same subject.
- iv. Regarding AECC-2(Ethics & Values Paper)
 - a. Valuation to be done internally with a remuneration of Rs 15 per paper subject to a minimum of Rs 150/-



b. Remuneration for invigilation duty is Rs 30 per invigilator as the duration of AECC-II (Ethics and Values) paper is 1 hour.

3) Matter Discussed regarding Student's Welfare:

In the virtual meeting with the principals of all affiliated colleges the following was discussed with regards to student's welfare activities:

- i. All the principals were informed about the schedule of University Cup &Vishwavidyalaya Cup English and Odia debate competitions.
- ii. It was instructed to them by DSW to finish the first round of the competitions by 30th September, 2022.
- iii. All the principals were also communicated to identify the nodal officer in their college for cultural & literary competitions and send their names and contact to DSW as soon as possible.
- iv. All were informed to use OIUC logo while organising any inter university related competitions.
- v. All the principals of affiliated colleges were asked to motivate the students at their personal level.
- vi. The principal also raised their doubts about the provision of TA/DA to the participants who will come to our University for final round of competitions.
- vii. All the principals were also invited virtually through link in the chat box to join the group for Inter University Competitions

4) Matters related to sports council

Director Sports Council, Prof.Jyotirmayee Acharya as a special invitee started with a warm welcome and informed about the new committee members joined in SC team including recruitment of new Physical Education Instructor.

- i. That the Certificate of Merit and Certificate of Participation are ready in the University. The same will be informed to the Principal in a letter from DSC so that the respective PET/representative of the college can collect the same from SC office by third week of September 2022.
- ii. That the pending annual fee deposit for the financial year 2021-22 of few Colleges need to be cleared at earliest. The annual fees for the financial year 2022-23 must be deposited on or before in the month of October 2022.
- iii. DSC informed about the letter received from Govt. of Odisha regarding the Hockey India (World Cup 2022). She proposed to create a women's Hockey team of RDWU by the representation of interested students of each college who will be chosen through an inter collage match. Also, to raise the awareness on the subject, RDWU may conduct essay, debate and poster competition in the Hockey subject in the month of November 2022. For this, she solicited thecooperation and support from all the affiliated colleges.
- iv. That as per the AIU Sports Calendar 2022-23, the University is also preparing its own calendar.

v. That the question of whether the Colleges can spend its 40% money to purchase equipments if not spent in the sports activities in that financial year will be communicated to the competent authority for suggestions.
