

## Proceedings of the Meeting of the Principals Held on 21.06.2022

A meeting of the principals' of all the Colleges affiliated to Rama Devi Women's University, was held on 21.06.2022. The meeting was chaired by Prof. Aparajita Chowdhury, Vice Chancellor, RDWU and coordinated by Prof. Chandi Charan Rath, Director, College Development Council, RDWU.

The following matters were discussed

### **1. College Development Council**

The Director, College Development Council, illustrated and placed the affiliation status of the colleges received from the Utkal University. The Director, CDC, requested the principals to complete all the affiliation programmes as per the status given by the Utkal University within a period of three months. He also discussed the status of the ten colleges which were not dis-affiliated from the Utkal University. It is observed that two colleges are already granted with NoC, and the file is under process for issue of NoC of other eight colleges. The Director, CDC also discussed about the deposit of affiliation fees and CDC fees for students collected for the academic session 2021-22. Principals of all the affiliated colleges were requested to deposit the above fees by 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2022.

### **2. Examination Section**

The Controller of Examinations discussed about the rules and regulations of examination pattern for the different admission batches. She emphatically

discussed about the midsemester examinations to be conducted in time and to complete the entry of marks and deposit of mark foil to the concerned section of the University within the specified time line. She advised to conduct the Midsemester examinations for students twice in a semester. She also discussed the mode of dispatch of answer scripts to the University in time.

### **3. Sports Council**

The Director sports council, addressed the principals and discussed about the status of different events to be held in the academic session 2022-23 and requested all the principals to take special interest to encourage the students for their participation in inter college and inter University level competitions in the state and National level. She also informed the august gathering that different sports equipment will be distributed to all the 48 colleges affiliated to our University from the IDP, (OHEPEE) fund.

### **4. Students Welfare**

The Director, Students Welfare discussed about different extracurricular activities conducted by our University as well as by the Odisha state Higher Education Council (HE, dept. Govt. of Odisha). She placed that, besides Vice Chancellor's and Chancellor's level Completions of the University, various competitions such as sports & games, athletics, literature, drawing, music etc are conducted at inter University level by HE, Dept. She advised the principals to encourage their students to participate in these events. She also placed that a team for each event, from RDWU will be formed based on selection trials for different competitions, in the RDWU campus, to participate at inter University level competitions.

### **5. NSS**

The Coordinator NSS discussed about different activities to be undertaken by the NSS units at college level. She also advised to submit the UC of the money sanctioned and released, to NSS units of respective Colleges in time. It was also decided to hold NSS camps in the RDWU campus as well as in the colleges from this academic year.


6. NCC


