Report of the meeting of the Principals held on 25.04.2023

A one-day Principals' meet on "Awareness Program on New Education Policy-2020 and its implication" was conducted on 25th April, 2023 from 11 AM to 3 PM by College Development Council of Rama Devi Women's University in the Academic Block 1 Auditorium. The objective of the program was to educate the Principals of the 48 affiliated colleges under Rama Devi University, Bhubaneswar, and Odisha regarding the National education Policy (NEP) 2020. The said program was funded by Institutional Development Plan (IDP), under Odisha Higher Education Project for equity and excellence, department of Higher Education, Government of Odisha. The event was participated by the Principals of Affiliated Colleges of RDWU and faculties along with Ph.D. Scholars from Rama Devi Women's University and conducted by Dr Sasmita Kar Sarangi, Assistant Professor, Department of Teacher Education.

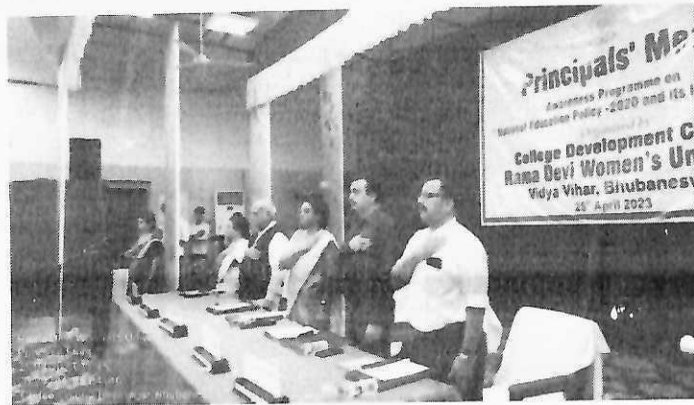
The Awareness Program was organized in two sessions:

Pre-launch session

The first session of the programme started with the inaugural function under the chairmanship of Professor Aparajita Choudhury, Vice Chancellor, Rama Devi Women's University as chief guest. Prof. Atanu Kumar Pati, the chief speaker of the event highlighted upon the mission and vision of NEP-2022 while discussing about various Educational schemes various that started since 1964. He added the research dimensions of the policy and emphasized the enhancement of learning through mother tongue based education. Vice Chancellor, Prof. Aparajita Choudhury focused on the reforms in the education system of the country due to timely introduction of NEP-2020. Mr. Durga Prasad Dash, Additional Director of National e-Governance Division, Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology discussed the utility of digital platform like Digilocker for getting certificates and other associated documents as and when required by the students and other stakeholders of higher education. He also discussed about the processes and mechanisms for registration in the Digilocker. Chairman, PG Council, Prof. Chandi Charan Rath said that the 48 affiliated colleges are the constituent part of the university and they need to be aware of the benefits of NEP-2020 that is going to be implemented in the near future.

The session ended with the felicitation of the guests by Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Pro. Aparajita Choudhury.

The post-lunch session was attended by Director, CDC, Prof. Sasmita Mohanty, CoE, RDWU, Dr Mamata Mohanty, Director, Sports Council, Prof. Jyotirmayee Acharya, the Programme Coordinator, NSS, Dr. Susant Kumar, Patnaik and the NAAC Coordinator of affiliated colleges, Dr Bibudhendu Pati where they discussed different issues faced by the Principals in the respective sections.

The following matters were discussed in the post-lunch session:

1. College Development Council

The Director, CDC discussed the affiliation status of the Colleges received the Utkal University and regarding the submission of NOC form Utkal University, BBSR. The Director, CDC, requested the principals of Colleges to submit the CDC fees, affiliation fees, one time NOC fees and one time Academic fees timely. It is observed that 44 Colleges paid CDC fees, 45 Colleges paid affiliation fees, 40 Colleges paid NOC fees and 39 Colleges paid Academic fees. Principals of all the affiliated Colleges were also requested to deposit the above fees by 31st July every year.

2. Examination section

The Controller of Examination discussed about the rules and regulations of examination pattern and syllabus. She deliberated upon the timely completion of the mid-semester examinations and the entry of marks thereof within the specified timeline. Timely dispatch and mode of answer scripts to the University and the arrangement of externals for the practical examinations and valuation of the examination was also discussed.

3. Sports council

The Director, Sports Council, addressed the principals and discussed about the success of organizing different events in the academic session 2022-23 and requested all the principals to take special interest to encourage the students for their participation in Inter-College and Inter-University level competitions in the State and National level. She also thanked the participating Colleges in the Inter-University Hockey Tournament 2023 and Inter-College Competitions 2023.

4. NSS

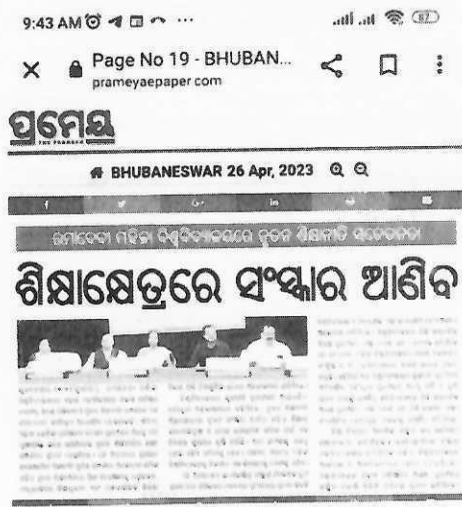

5. NAAC

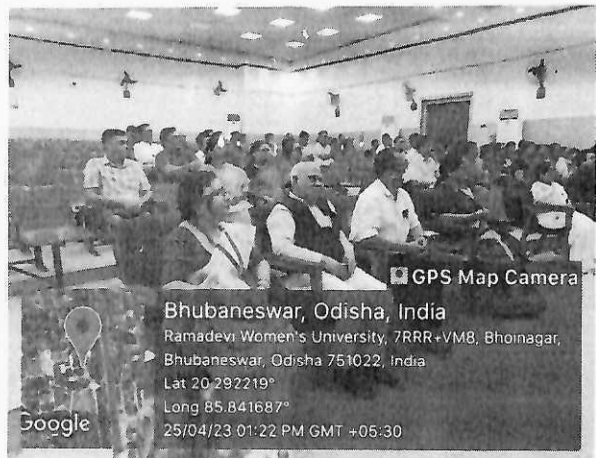


