"Leadership for Growth: Vision for Academic, Administrative and Infrastructural Growth of the College"

Report of the meeting of the Principals held on 03.11.2025

A one-day Principals' Meet and Talk on the theme "Leadership for Growth: Vision for Academic, Administrative and Infrastructural Growth of the College" was organized on 3rd November 2025 from 11:00 AM to 3:00 PM by the College Development Council (CDC) of Rama Devi Women's University, Bhubaneswar, at the Rama Devi Auditorium.

The programme aimed to facilitate one-to-one interaction with the Principals of the 48 affiliated colleges and to address any administrative or academic challenges they encounter in managing college affairs. As part of the event, an inspiring lecture titled "Leadership for Growth: Vision for Academic, Administrative and Infrastructural Development of the College" was delivered by Prof. Madhumita Das, an eminent academician and former Vice Chancellor of Fakir Mohan University, Balasore. Her talk sought to motivate the Principals by emphasizing the importance of fostering academic excellence, enhancing administrative efficiency, and advancing infrastructural growth. The event was marked by the enthusiastic participation of the Principals of RDWU's affiliated colleges.

Programme Structure

The programme was conducted in **two sessions**:

1. Pre-Lunch Session

The inaugural session commenced under the chairmanship of Prof. Chandi Charan Rath, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor (I/C), Rama Devi Women's University, who graced the occasion as the Chief Guest. The distinguished guests on the dais included Prof. Madhumita Das, Former Vice Chancellor, Fakir Mohan University, Balasore, Odisha, as the Speaker and Smt. Manaswini Sahu, Registrar, RDWU.

2. Post-Lunch Session

The session focused on various academic and administrative issues raised by the Principals. The following key points were discussed:

1. College Development Council (CDC)

Prof. Sasmita Mohanty discussed the affiliation status and CDC activities during the academic year 2024–25. Principals were instructed to submit recognition copies up to 2024–25 for affiliation processing. She also requested timely submission of CDC fees, affiliation fees, and booklet fees by 31st July every year, failing which fines would be applicable.

2. Regional Director of Education, Bhubaneswar

Dr. Jitendra Sahoo discussed matters related to granting recognition copies to affiliated colleges and the challenges faced in the process.

3. National Service Scheme (NSS)

Prof. Aliva Mohanty, Programme Coordinator, NSS, discussed various NSS activities to be undertaken at the college level and evaluated the performance of NSS units. She also stressed the importance of timely submission of Social Service fees by all affiliated colleges.

4. NAAC Accreditation

Prof. Bibudhendu Pati, NAAC Coordinator, highlighted the rules, regulations, and benefits of implementing NAAC standards in educational institutions. He encouraged all Principals to prepare NAAC-related documents meticulously and shared inspirational examples from other accredited institutions.

5. Sports Council

Dr. Itishri Sarangi, Director, Sports Council, discussed the various sports activities conducted during the academic year 2024–25 and reviewed the status of sports fee submission by the affiliated colleges. She encouraged Principals to motivate students to participate actively in inter-college and university-level sports events to promote holistic development.

The meeting concluded with a formal Vote of Thanks proposed by Prof. Sasmita Mohanty, Director, CDC, Rama Devi Women's University, expressing gratitude to all guests, participants, and organizers for making the event a success.


