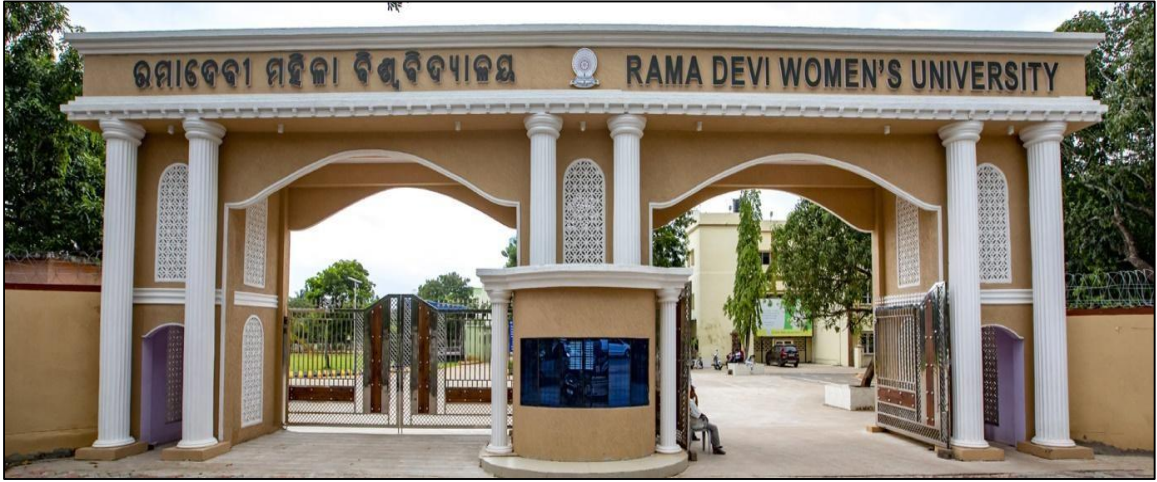

Each student is required to present the review of related studies through power-point. All the Ph.D. and P.G. Students of the Department shall remain present and

participate in the discussion. There will be an open viva-voce test after the presentation. Assessment shall be made on the basis the following criteria:

- 1) Relevance of the Reviews.
- 2) Finding the research gap.
- 3) Standard and Quality of writing the review.
- 4) Style of presentation.
- 5) Answering the question of Examiners.
- 6) Clarification of Queries raised by the participants.
