NOTIFICATION

The Urgent meeting of the Syndicate of Rama Devi Women's University was held on 31.01.2018 at 11.30 A.M. in the University Conference Hall and was chaired by the Vice-Chancellor Prof. (Dr.) Padamaja Mishra. The Items discussed were resolved as follows:

The Registrar Shri Jayanta Narayan Sarangi, presented the resolutions of the meeting of the Committee for Recruitment held on 16.01.2018 and 18.01.2018 with regard to the eligibility criteria, reservation, distributions of posts, qualification, fees, terms and conditions, application procedures, etc. for recruitment of 67 nos. of teaching posts (Professor (13), Associate professor (18), Assistant Professor(36) for P.G. Departments of the University as follows:

Rama Devi Women's University, Bhubaneswar, Odisha is the only Women's University in the state of Odisha. It was established on 30th May 2015 vide Higher Education Department, Government of Odisha Notification No. 11605/HE dated 30.05.2015 in exercise of powers conferred as per The Odisha University Act,1989 read as The Odisha Universities First Statues,1990. It is located in the capital city of Bhubaneswar spreading over a sprawling 24.57 acre area adjacent to NH 16 at the heart of the city. This is the only Women's affiliating university in the state with 47 affiliated Women's Colleges covering nine districts of Odisha. This University caters to the needs of higher education to the girl students of Odisha and other States.

Resolution

All the Honourable members appreciated the move and accepted the proposal unanimously.

Proposal No-2

With permission of the Chairperson, the Registrar placed the file with regard to CoF's proposal to appoint Sri Gobardhan Nayak on contractual basis @ Rs.9300/-p.m. as he retired on 31.01.2018.He was maintaining all the Accounts of the University and the Erstwhile R. D.Women's College. As University has not appointed any regular staff so far, it would be very difficult to do all accounts works in his absence or without appointment of the regular staff. The proposal was to appoint him from 05.02.2018 till the end of the Current Financial Year.

Resolution

Dr.Gopinath Kar said that the posts of non-teaching staff has not been created till date and accounts works of the University is very important and sensitive. In view of that at least one experienced staff is necessary to manage the accounts works of the University. So, Sri Nayak, may be engaged on contact basis on consolidated pay of Rs.9300/-(Rupees Nine Thousand Three Hundred) only for one year from the date of engagement or till further decision whichever is earlier. All other members appreciated the suggestion and accepted that unanimously.
