NOTIFICATION

The 19th meeting of Syndicate of the University was held on 24.12.2019 at 03.30 p.m. in the University Conference Hall under the chairmanship of Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor Prof. (Dr.)Padmaja Mishra. The items discussed were resolved as follows:

ITEM-01

To consider the 40% enhancement of rate of printing of question papers of the University from January 2020 as per the letter of the firm 'Chilika' given on 19.12.2019.

The confidential firm was engaged for printing of confidential question papers. As per the contract signed between the CoE and the firm, the firm is supposed to print question papers for various examinations to be held in 2018-2021, with the approved price. Meanwhile, the firm vide letter No. Nil dated 19.12.2019 has asked for 40% increase in the approved price (as per contract) due to rise in cost of paper, printing transportation establishment etc. ~~the firm requested that if 40% enhancement the rate of confidential printing is not hiked by the University, the firm will not carry out the printing of confidential material from Jan, 2020.~~

At present, the UG 3rd, 5th and PG 3rd semester examinations 2019 are over, for which the firm has done the confidential printing of question papers. The firm has submitted the bill for the said work amounting to Rs.2, 06,925 (Rupees two lakhs six thousand nine hundred twenty five) only, for which the firm has not asked for rise of 40% in price.

Presently, the UG (R & B) and PG 1st semester examination is ahead and scheduled to be held from Jan 13th 2020. The approximate cost of printing of question for these examinations would be Rs. 2, 20,000/- (Rupees two lakhs twenty thousand) only as per the approved price. Rise in 40% in printing of question papers for the above said examinations will have an additional financial implication of Rs. 88,000 to the University approximately. In total the University has to pay Rs. 3, 08,000/- (Rupees three lakhs eight thousand) only to the firm after 40% increase. If the firm is allowed to carry out printing of question papers for all the examinations [(UG, PG, M. Phil., 1st semester, UG (2nd, 4th and 6th semester), PG (2nd semester), M. Phil., (2nd Semester), B. Ed. (1st and 2nd year)] for the academic session 2019-20, the approximate cost of printing of question papers would be Rs. 6,85,000/- (Rupees six lakhs eighty five thousand) only. 40% rise in the price would cost an extra financial implications of Rs. 2,74000/- (Rupees two lakhs seventy four thousands) only to the University. The University has to pay Rs. 9, 59,000/- (Rupees nine lakhs fifty nine thousands) only, approximately to the firm for printing of question papers for all the examinations of the academic session

2019-2020.

Meanwhile, the CoE, has contacted other firms for printing of question papers located in the state. The firms quoted the price which is three times higher than the price of the existing firm. Hence, it is suggested to consider the existing firm for printing of confidential question papers of the University.

Resolution: Resolved that the printing of question paper be given to the existing confidential firm with 40% enhancement of the rate of existing cost from January- 2020 till the end of the contract.

ITEM-02

To consider the ratification of the approval of the Vice Chancellor on new fee structure in respect of different examination processes as prescribed by Dept. of Higher Education, Govt. of Odisha vide letter No-HE-FE-MISC-0019-2019/8845 dated 13.09.2019.

The proposal has been approved by the Vice Chancellor on 13.12.2019 I file No- CoE-EC-02at Page 19/N.

Resolution: The approval of the Vice Chancellor on new fee structure in respect of different examination processes as prescribed by Dept. of Higher Education, Govt. of Odisha vide letter No-HE-FE-MISC-0019-2019/8845 dated 13.09.2019 was ratified.

ITEM-03

To consider the ratification of the approval of Vice Chancellor on enhancement of Honorarium of the Doctor and attendant of the University Health Centre (Ayushi) w.e.f January 2020.

The Vice Chancellor has approved the proposal of enhancement of Honorarium of the Doctor and attendants of the University Health Centre w.e.f. January, 2020 in Ayushi on 17.12.2019.

Resolution: The approval of Vice Chancellor on enhancement of Honorarium of the Doctor and attendant of the University Health Centre (Ayushi) w.e.f January 2020 was ratified.

ITEM-04

To consider the approval of the engagement of P.S to VC, PA to Registrar and PET from among the retired employees on contractual basis.

Since the post of P.S to VC, PA to Registrar and PET are essential for day to day running of the University administration, it is proposed to engage the aforesaid personnel from among the retired employees on contractual basis.

Resolution: The proposal of engagement of P.S to VC, PA to Registrar and PET from among the retired employees on contractual basis was approved.
