
Youth Red Cross Annual Report 2023-24

The tragic Train Accident held at Bahanaga on June 02,2023. Our YRC counsellor Dr. Rebatikanta Maharana and Volunteer Priyanka Panda voluntarily donated blood for the casualties. For this Nobel work counsellor Dr. Rebatikanta Maharana and Volunteer Priyanka Panda awarded letter of appreciation by the Govt. of Odisha on recommendation of Higher Education Department for rendering their selfless and dedicated service in time from 02.06.2023 to 05.06.2023 to the victims of Train accident Tragedy at Bahanaga, Balasor, Odisha.











Heritage Rally
















On 30/03/2024 five YRC Volunteers along with Counsellor Dr Rebatikant Maharana attended one day workshop on 'Capacity
